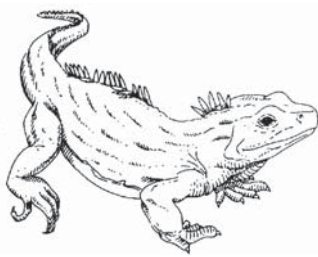




A Rocha Aotearoa New Zealand

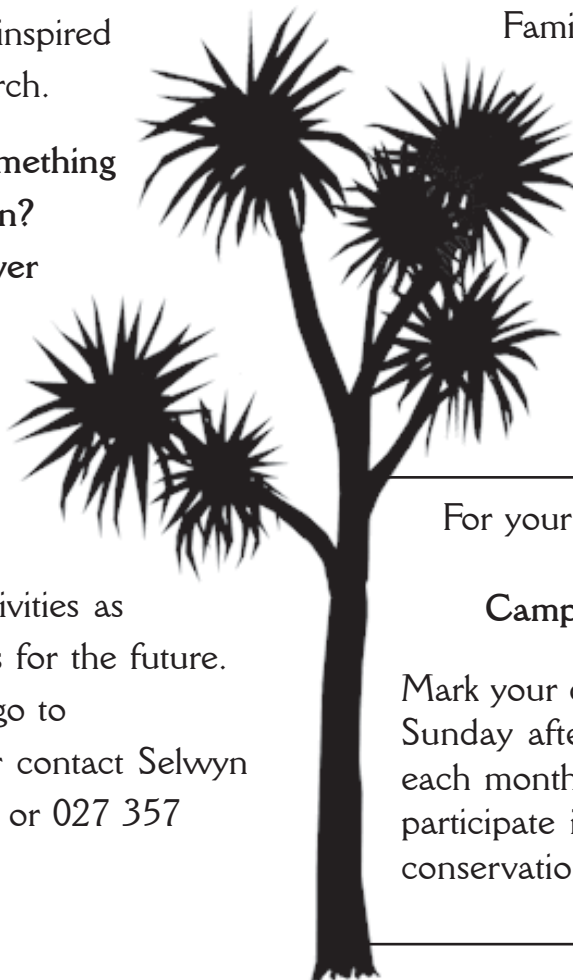
Sunday March 20th Orokonui Ecosanctuary
