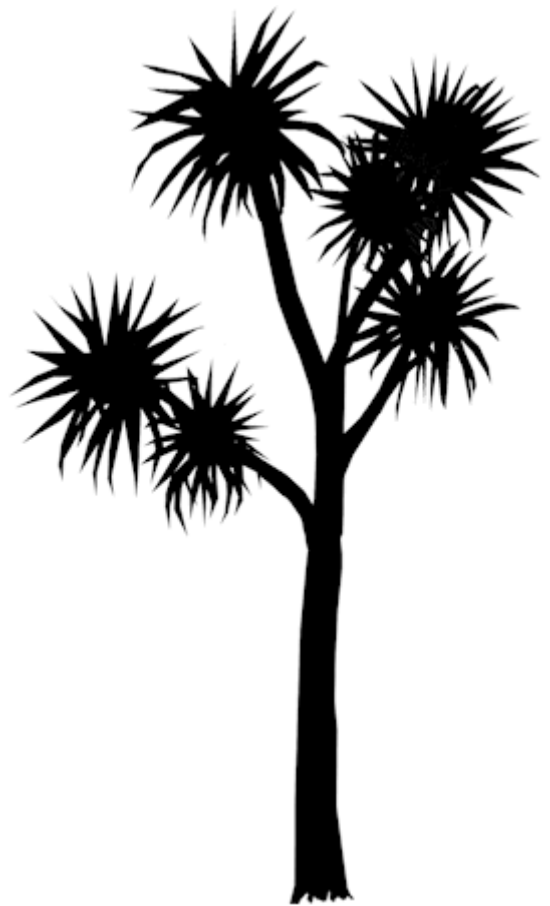
Bring
